Introduction

In this class you will be introduced to the basics of hand quilting. The basic quilting stitch is nothing more than a running stitch sewn through three thin layers. Mickey and Joanne will help you start from layering and basting your quilt, putting your quilt into a hoop and the hand quilting stitch. You will be on firm footing with tips learned from two experienced and accomplished hand quilters.

Fabrics Needed

Needles, muslin fabric, batting and thread will be provided by the instructors.

Notions Needed

- hoop - 10" or 12" wooden hoop works best but if you have another kind, it needs to have a screw for tightening. Check Joann's with a 40% off coupon. Make certain to have a quilting hoop, not an embroidery hoop
- small scissors
- 2 thimbles
- sharp #2 pencil

Pre-class Preparation

If you have a 7"-8" block you have worked on, please bring it. No other preparation is necessary.
