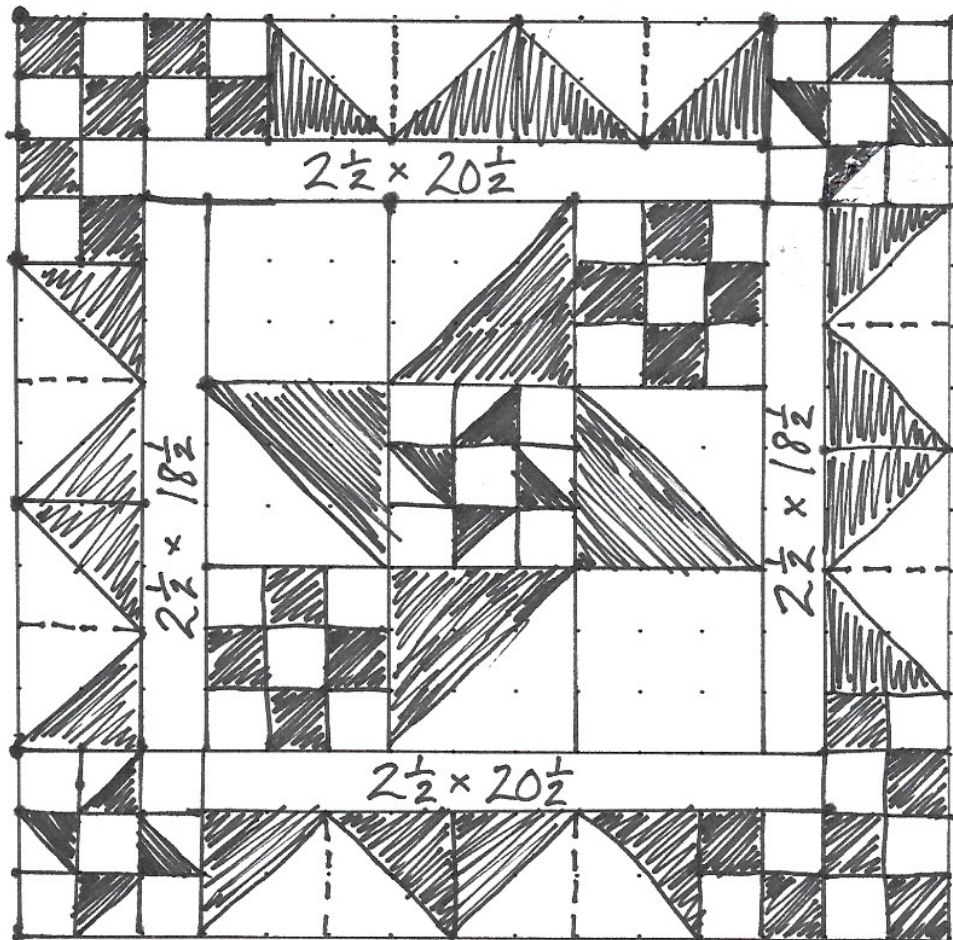
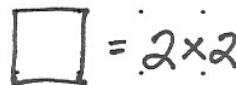


## Corona Quilt Assembly and Layout

I hope you will feel free to disregard or change any portion of this layout plan. Obviously as in any pattern, this is just a suggestion and you complete the quilt as you wish.

I suggest that you lay out your completed blocks to see if you like the color placements, etc. In the outer border I went back and forth as to whether the dark triangles in the flying geese/HST should face inward or toward the outer edge. I originally had them the reverse of what's shown here. The new friendship stars that I made after the puppy chewing incident made me change my mind. You also might want to rotate the 4 large HST in the center units to surround or frame the center friendship star differently. I had quite a few other possible arrangements before I settled on this one. I decided I wanted to feature the friendship star "concept" to help remember our guild's working together on our mask making during the pandemic, and our solidarity throughout the year. I'm hoping the triangles/geese in the outer border give somewhat a crown or star effect to harken to the "corona".

I pieced this together by making 5 units from the blocks and then joining them with a partial seam technique. If you have come up with an alternate layout, you will need to plan your assembly accordingly. I will be happy to assist anyone who has questions.
